

# Project Tutorial: Congratulations Card



## Project Supplies

**PAPER:** Whisper White & Rich Razzleberry Card Stock, Fabulous Foil Designer Acetate (Silver Side), and Silver Foil Sheet

**STAMP SET:** Birthday Blast

**INK:** Versamark and Silver Embossing Powder

**EMBELLISHMENTS:** NONE

**TOOLS:** Star Blast Edgelits Dies, Big Shot Die-Cutting Machine, Die Brush, Embossing Buddy and Heat Tool

**ADHESIVES:** Snail and Stampin' Dimensionals



## Measurements

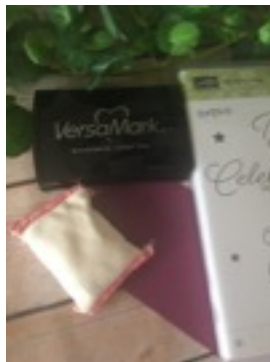
- Whisper White card base is 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece that is scored at 4-1/4"
- Fabulous Foil Designer Acetate Card Front Panel is 5-1/4" x 3"
- Rich Razzleberry Card Stock Front Panel is 5-1/4" x 2-1/2"
- Silver Foil Sheet is cut at 5-1/4" x 3"

## **Instructions**

- 1) Use the Big Shot Die Cut Machine die-cut the Star Blast image onto the Silver Foil Sheet. Use the Big Shot Die Brush to remove any remaining pieces from the Star Blast die-cut image. Retain the largest star and the two smaller stars for later.



- 2) Brush over the Rich Razzlberry piece thoroughly with the Stampin' Buddy.



- 3) Stamp the 'Celebrate You' sentiment onto the lower center of the Rich Razzlberry piece with Versamark ink.
- 4) Pour the Silver Embossing Powder over the stamped image, shake the powder off, and dry with the Heat Tool.



## **Instructions (cont.)**

- 5) Line up the Rich Razzleberry piece on top of the Silver Foil die-cut piece (at the score line on the Silver Foil piece) and attach with Snail.



- 6) Arrange the Fabulous Foil piece in a landscape position with the silver side up. Apply Snail along the lower edge of the Fabulous Foil.
- 7) Layer the Rich Razzleberry piece on top of the lower edge of the Fabulous Foil and adhere. The Silver Foil Star Blast die cut piece will “float” above the Fabulous Foil.



- 8) Place Snail on the back of the Rich Razzleberry piece. Adhere this piece to the Whisper White card base.

## **Instructions (cont.)**



- 9) Cut a Stampin' Dimensional in half and then cut one of the halves in half again. You should end up with three little pieces. Adhere the largest piece to the largest silver star that you had remaining from your die cut, and adhere the two smaller pieces to the two smaller stars. Place the stars as shown on the Rich Razzleberry panel.
- 10) Here is what your card will look like when completed.
